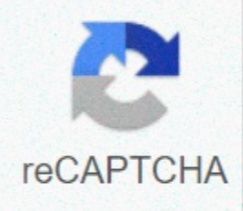

Kansas dcf hotline report

Reporting abuse in Kansas is a sexual ethics violation report in Kansas using the free reporting line: 877-771-7003 mandatory reporting of the Kansas Law 38-2223 lists those who are assigned reporters in Kansas. If you don't know if you're in a assigned reporter class, go to the Kansas DCF website, www.dcf.ks.gov to find out. The certificate does not automatically make a mandatory reporter. Clerics are not required under Kansas law to report suspected violations, however, the 2008 Disciplinary Book requires clergy to report suspected violations. Report child abuse to anyone who has the right to report suspected abuse directly to the state at 800-722-5330. The Guide to Reporting Child Abuse and Neglect in Kansas is an excellent resource, and is found on the Development Cooperation Fund website, www.dcf.ks.gov. Child Registration and Abuse Unit, call 800-932-0313 (TTD: 866-872-1677) to report violations in Nebraska law requiring anyone suspected of having been physically, sexually or negligently abused to report it immediately to an adult and child neglect hotline of the Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services: 1-800-652-1999. The purpose of the Act is to provide protection for children whose health and well-being are adversely affected and are further threatened by the behaviour of those responsible for their care and protection. The reporters assigned include the staff of The Children's Service. Failure to report is a misdemeanor. Any person who submits a report in good faith is safe from any civil or criminal liability. Hotline for the abuse and neglect of adults and children: 1-800-652-1999 Requires the Unified Methodist Discipline Book of clergy to report suspected abuse.
